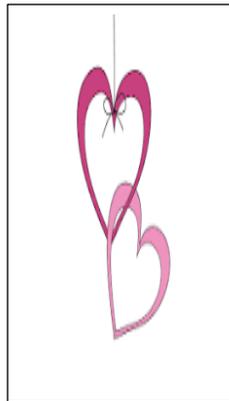




# Superintendent's Message
